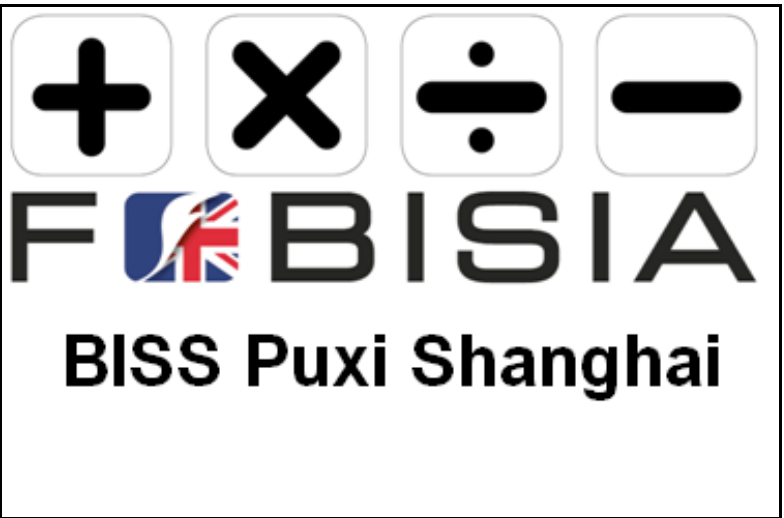

- 6.) The tea set did not have 140rmb knocked off and was not bought by Gabriel or Anneka.
